## About the Workshop–

The **Workshop on ‘Ayurveda Manuscriptology’** is designed to create awareness as well as give hands on training on Ayurveda Manuscripts using the advanced technology. It is designed for people who are willing to learn and apply the knowledge in reviving the ancient knowledge. The workshop also help in understanding the already published works in a critical manner. This workshop will be completed in two phases. Phase I includes 10 sessions (5 Lectures + 5 Practicals) and focusses on the basics of manuscriptology. Phase II includes 10 sessions (5 Lectures + 5 Practicals) and focusses on advanced manuscriptology such as editing and textual criticism. The participants will have to attend the sessions in NIA. The certificate will be awarded only after the completion of each of the phase.
